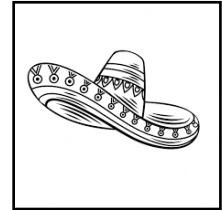

Movie Review**Did You Already Watch Kung Fu Panda?****By Claudia Puig**

Though occasionally visually inventive, Kung Fu Panda is a disappointment when it comes to matters of simple black-and-white script. It did not call my attention at any time. I expected something different.

The story centers on the enthusiastic, if clumsy Po (Jack Black), a kung fu fan. Po's job is to work in his family's noodle shop. When he is accidentally chosen as the kung fu master who will fulfill an ancient prophecy.

Despite the panda voiced by Black, the humorous moments are few. The supporting characters include a tiger voiced by Angelina Jolie, a crane played by David Cross, Lucy Liu as a viper, and Jackie Chan as an agile monkey.

Sure, the message to believe in yourself is a valuable, if often heard, one for young audiences. But it could have played out more creatively.

Perhaps the most interesting character is Master Shifu, charmingly voiced by Dustin Hoffman. He whips Po into shape and reveals his character. One sequence on a swinging wooden bridge is a visual treat, especially when seen in IMAX. But the film's climax doesn't show the fate of the bad guy. This lack of clarity might have more to do with plans for a sequel than bad storytelling.

Osa Conservation

Founded in 2003, Osa Conservation is a nonprofit organization dedicated mainly to protecting the globally significant biodiversity of the Osa Peninsula.

We protect Osa's natural ecosystems by:

- creating biological corridors for local wildlife
- managing and protecting the Osa National Wildlife Refuge
- building successful models for private conservation
- restoring damaged and degraded ecosystems



Our Projects

Sea Turtle: Our sea turtle conservation program monitors the nesting activity, predation rates, and hatching success of these incredible species. Our staff and volunteers gather important population and reproductive data and deter poachers who collect turtle eggs for consumption or sale.

Camera Trap: In 2013, the National University (UNA) and Osa Conservation created the Camera Trap Network for the Osa Peninsula. This initiative, now the largest camera trap array in Costa Rica, is composed of NGOs, hotels, eco-lodges, and private landowners who are willing to contribute to the research and conservation of the wild cats and their prey in the Osa Peninsula.

Forest Restoration: We provide oversight of the Osa National Wildlife Refuge (ONWR) and actively protect and manage a 1,400-acre reserve along the Esquinas River which includes forest and mangrove habitats, essential to many migratory birds and other wildlife.

What Is Wearable Technology?

Wearable technology, or “wearables”, is the name for the type of electronic devices people can wear as accessories, implanted in their clothing, or even in their bodies. Wearables are hands-free gadgets with microprocessors and a connection to the Internet.



Wearables have existed for hundreds of years. Pocket watches, which later became wristwatches, or glasses were some of the first examples in the history of wearable technology. People wore them to have a more comfortable life, and they still do. Glasses help you see, and watches give you helpful information. However, modern wearable devices are more complicated. They are electronic and use the Internet to collect, store and send information.

The first popular electronic wearable technology was fitness trackers which became popular in the 2010s. They monitor people’s hearts and movements and help them keep fit. Now, wearable technology helps people stay healthy in new ways. For example, the *ITBra* is a patch that women wear inside their bras, and it checks for breast cancer. *SmartSleep* is a soft headband, that helps people to sleep better. It collects information about people’s sleep patterns, gives advice, and makes sounds to help people fall asleep.

However, not all wearables are about health. Some are used for protection or to find the place you want to go, and some are just for fun. For example, you can buy smart jewelry. These rings and necklaces can change color to match clothes or make-up, or they can send the police an alert if you are in danger.
