The ARA Project is a Costa Rican licensed zoological park and non-profit organization dedicated mainly to the conservation of the two native macaw species of Costa Rica: the endangered Great Green Macaw (Ara ambiguous) and the Scarlet Macaw (Ara Macao). The project operates a breeding and reintroduction project. Visitors and tourists are also welcome to visit the park.

Volunteering with us?

The breeding center is where the breeding stock is kept and where the captive bred macaws are kept until they move on to a release site.

It is possible to volunteer at the center combined with an internship; the ARA Project can provide appropriate supervision and an evaluation reference. Responsibilities include:

- Feeding macaws
- Maintaining aviaries (mostly cleaning)
- Observing behavior
- Environmental enrichment
- Maintaining grounds around the breeding center
- Conservation education (Knowledge in biology not required)



How Does Zoom Work?

Zoom is an online audio and web conferencing platform. People use it to make phone calls or to participate in video conference meetings. You don't need a paid subscription to start using Zoom. You'll need to click a link to install the Zoom app, and then enter the conference code to sign into the meeting to which you've been invited.



What To Do?

To start your own Zoom Meeting, you'll need an account, which you can create for free. Go to the Zoom Web site, click Sign Up, and follow the instructions. Once completed, you'll be able to start your meetings.

Zoom offers several plans. Basic is free and lets you host meetings with up to 100 participants, with a limit of 40 minutes per meeting. You can also have an unlimited number of one-on-one

meetings. All these meetings can be audio-only or video conferences.

Even for the free account, during the meeting, you can record and save your meetings, share your desktop with the meeting attendees, and use chat tools.



If the generous features of the free Basic plan are not enough, it's possible to pay for Zoom Pro, Zoom Business, or Zoom Enterprise. Each of these plans adds substantial additional features, like the ability to conference more than 100 people at a time and extend the meeting duration past 40 minutes (in fact, a meeting can be up to 24 hours long).

A Passion for Reggae

Robert "Bob" Nesta Marley is the greatest ever reggae singer. He mainly **spread** his message of love and unity to a worldwide audience through reggae. His live performances were legendary for his passion and energy.

Marley was born in 1945 in a small village in Jamaica to a white father and a black mother. The racist bullying he received as a child had an important impact on his songwriting. He left school at the age of 14 to make music. He met members of his future band The Wailers at a jam session. It took several years before they became famous.

The Wailers' first album "Catch a Fire" was released in 1973 and sold well. Another album followed a year later that included the song "I Shot The Sheriff". Eric Clapton's cover of the song in 1974 brought Marley a lot of global attention. In 1975, Marley released his breakthrough song "No Woman, No Cry", still regarded as a classic today.

Marley left Jamaica for England in 1976 to record his "Exodus" and "Kaya" albums. He toured the world and performed to campaign against apartheid in South Africa and to celebrate Zimbabwe's independence. He died of cancer in 1981, aged 36. He was given a state funeral in Jamaica according to the Rastafari tradition. He continues to be an important influence on today's music.

Do You Know What a Tsunami Is?

Tsunami waves are larger and faster than normal surface waves. A tsunami wave can travel as fast as a jet plane and can be as tall as a ten-story building. Imagine dropping a stone into a pond. The water on the surface ripples. A tsunami is like a very powerful ripple. Tsunamis begin when the ocean rises or falls very suddenly. Large amounts of seawater are displaced. This movement causes huge waves.

For a tsunami to occur, there must be some kind of force that causes the ocean water to become displaced. Most tsunamis are caused by underwater earthquakes. However, rarely volcanoes, landslides, large icebergs, and even meteorites can cause one of these mighty waves. Tsunamis are extremely powerful. Ordinary waves lose power when they break. Tsunami waves can remain powerful for several days.

Because tsunami waves are so strong, they can kill people, damage property, and completely ruin an ecosystem in just one hour. Scientists have no way of predicting when a tsunami will hit. However, if a powerful enough earthquake occurs, scientists can issue a warning or a watch. A warning means that a tsunami will very likely hit soon. In the minutes, hours, and days following a disaster, people are dealing with a wide range of physical and emotional stress. They may be in physical distress due to injuries sustained during the disaster. They may also be feeling a deep emotional stress brought on by the loss of property, control over their lives, and in some cases, the loss of loved ones. People are

also often concerned about "what's next" following a disaster, especially if their homes are damaged. Try to stay calm and do not get desperate. If you experience a disaster, the following tips will help you manage the situation.
